Artist & Teacher

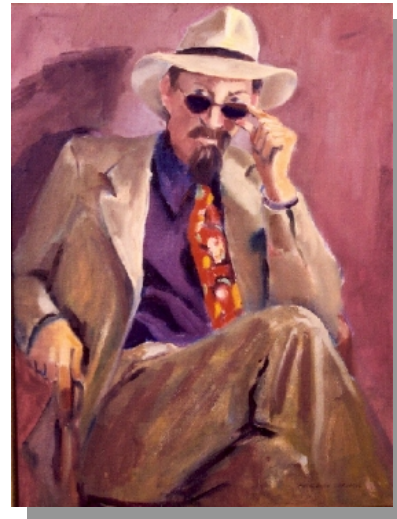
